

Electric motors must not exceed 750 watts (1HP)


Must have CPSC or other 3<sup>rd</sup> party certification







# Brazos Transit District

Current Texas A&M and Blinn students may ride the Brazos Transit District Fixed Routes in Bryan/ College Station for no charge if a current student ID is presented to the bus driver.

#### **FIXED ROUTES**

- Fixed routes travel the same path every hour on the hour, beginning and ending at the Transfer Point.
- You may board the bus anywhere along the route, just be on the same side of the street as the entrance of the bus!

#### **ADA PARATRANSIT**

• Shared ride curb-to-curb service offered for those who cannot access the Fixed Routes due to a disability, and have an origin and destination within ¾ of a mile along the Fixed Routes.

#### **DEMAND & RESPONSE**

- Shared ride curb-to-curb service for individuals who are either nondisabled or disabled and/or do not have an origin and destination within <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of a mile along the Fixed Routes.
- With no destination restrictions, we can take you anywhere you want to go within our service area.
- Ex: Shopping, to work, visiting friends and family, medical appointments, etc.


